

For more information about the NOFA and the application process, please go to www.hudexchange.info/e-snaps/fy-2016-coc-program-nofa-coc-program-competition/. As required by HUD regulations, all applications, along with required documentation must be submitted into e-snaps by no later than August 30, 2016 in order to be reviewed by the CoC. According to HUD, new projects must focus on permanent supportive housing for Chronically Homeless individuals/families, or Rapid Rehousing projects for homeless individuals/families. All NOFA applicants should read the FY 2016 CoC Program ~~Competition NOFA~~ ~~entirely~~ in conjunction with the CoC Program interim rule (24 CFR part 578) in order to ensure a comprehensive understanding and compliance with all CoC Program requirements. This NOFA frequently makes reference to citations from 24 CFR part 578. Applicants should review the FY 2016 General Section of the NOFA, published on October 21, 2014 as well as any additional Notices and HUD guidance provided in relation to the CoC Program.
